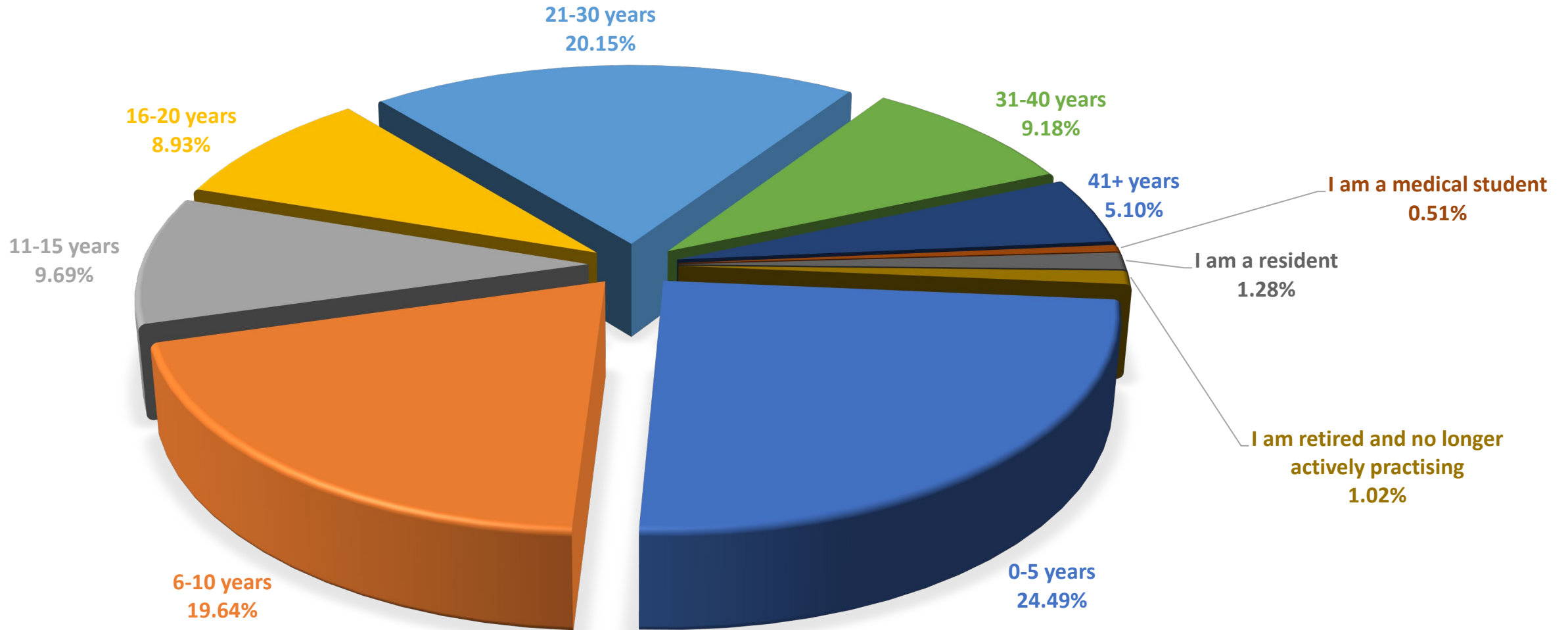

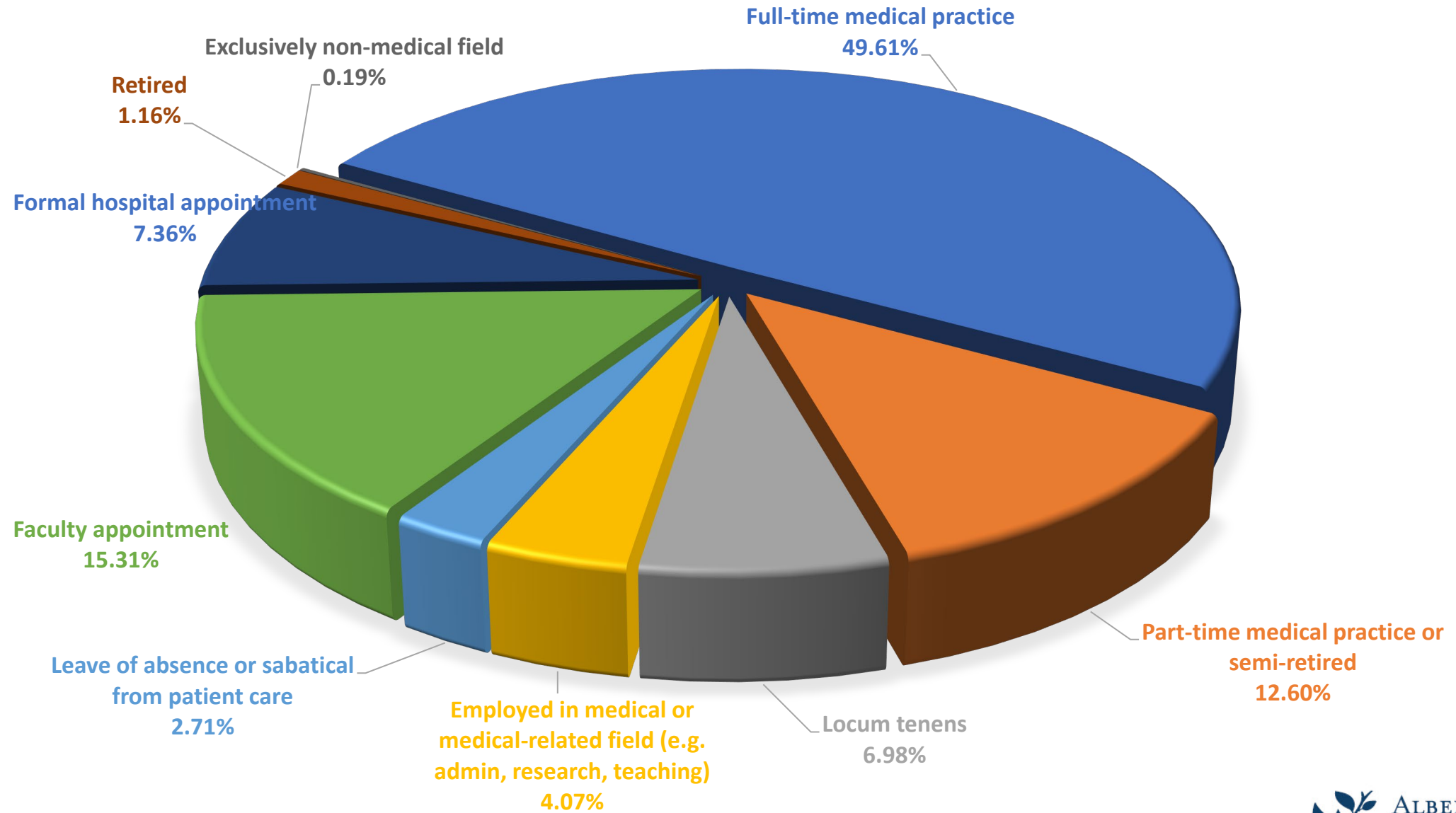
Purpose

- The following slides highlight the needs and interests of members and their perceptions on the ACFP's strategic direction, future considerations and issues weighing on members' minds, and desired areas of focus

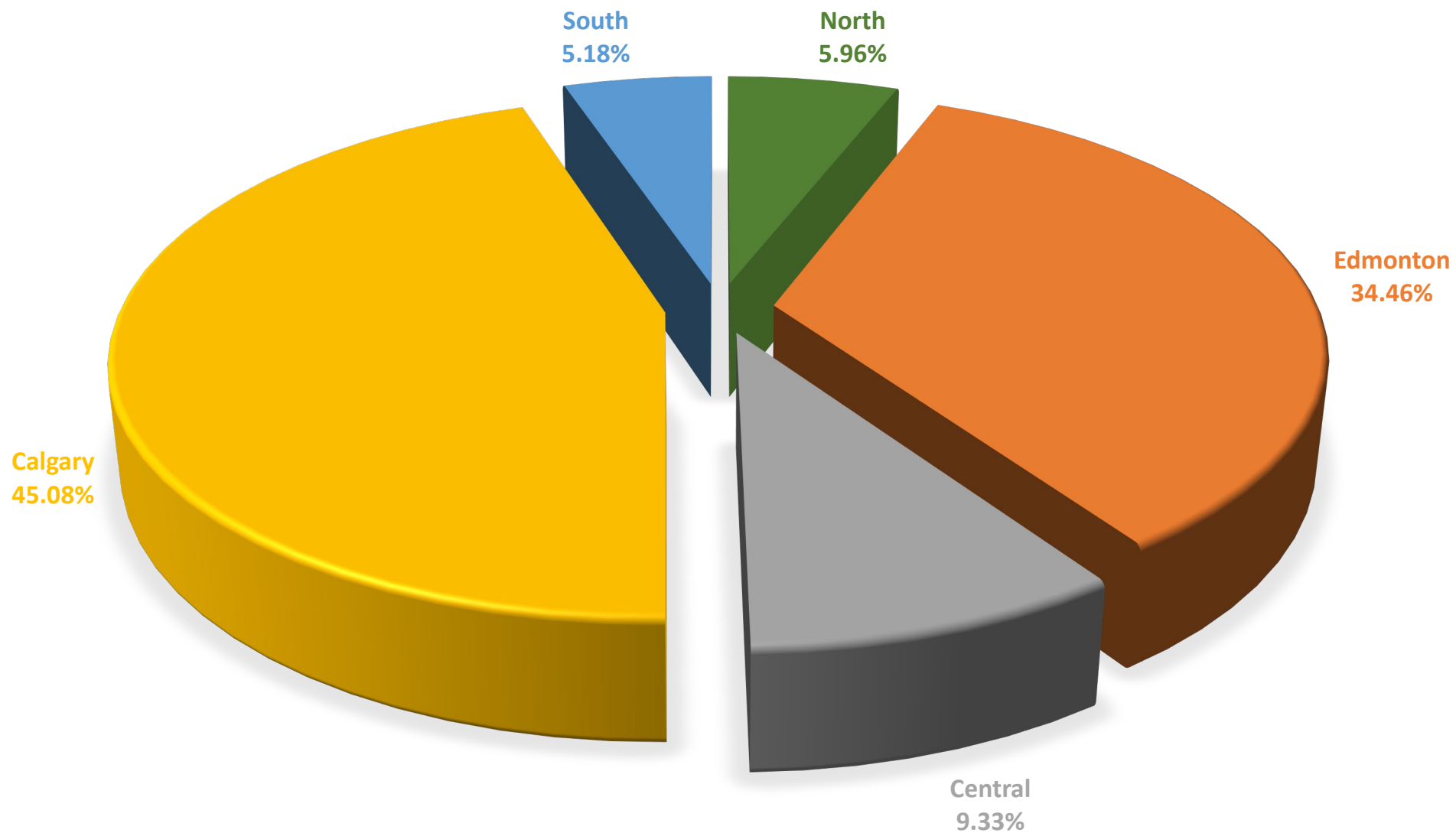
Years in Practice



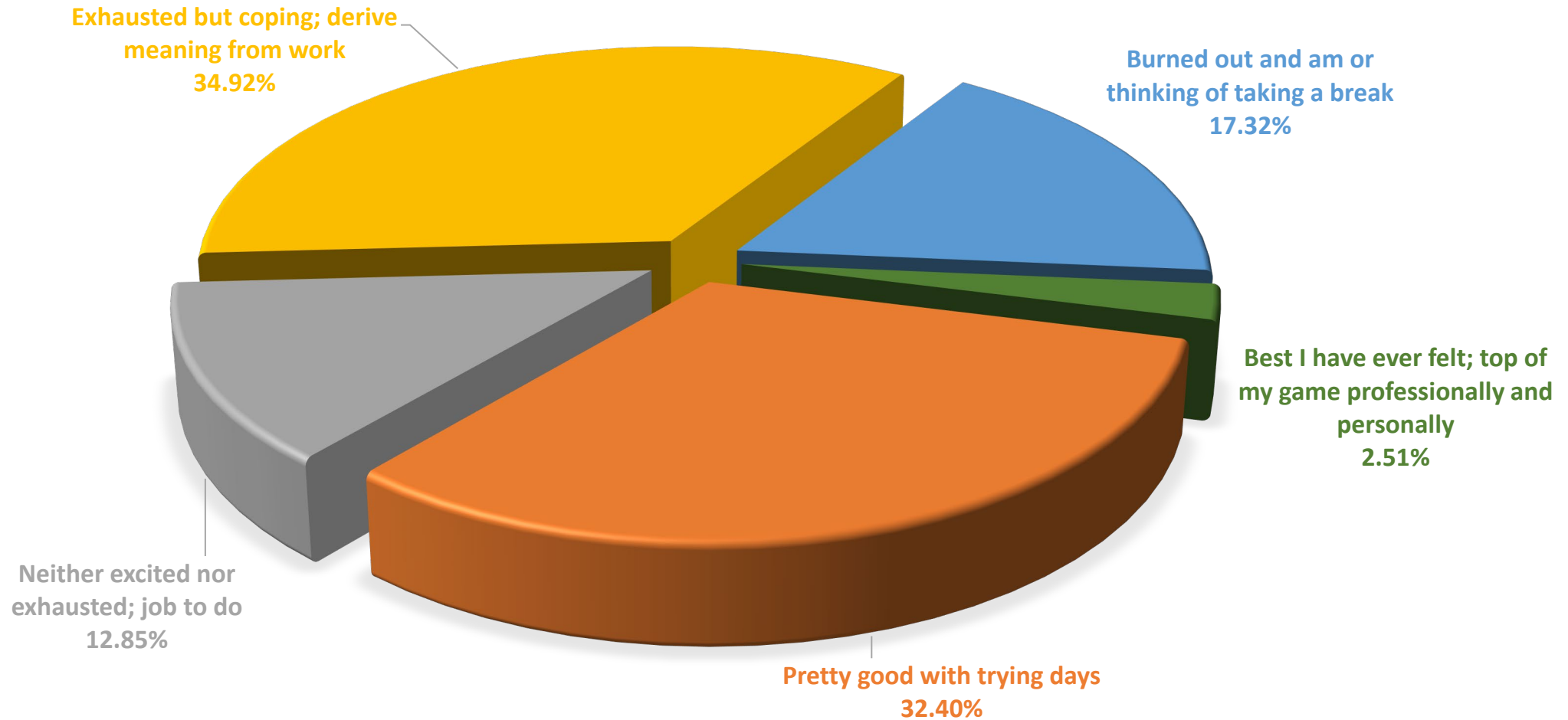
Practice Type



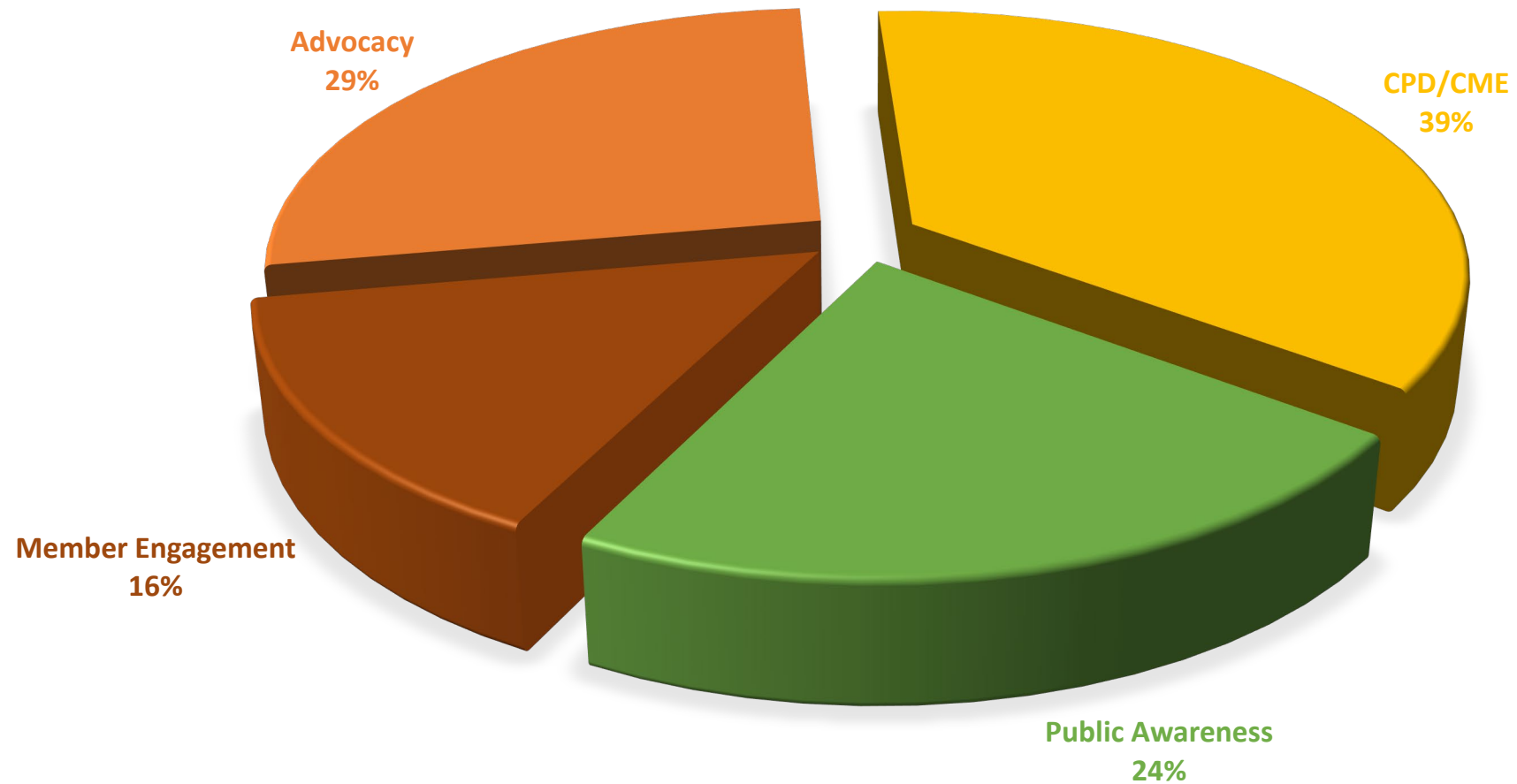

Feelings About Day-to-Day Work

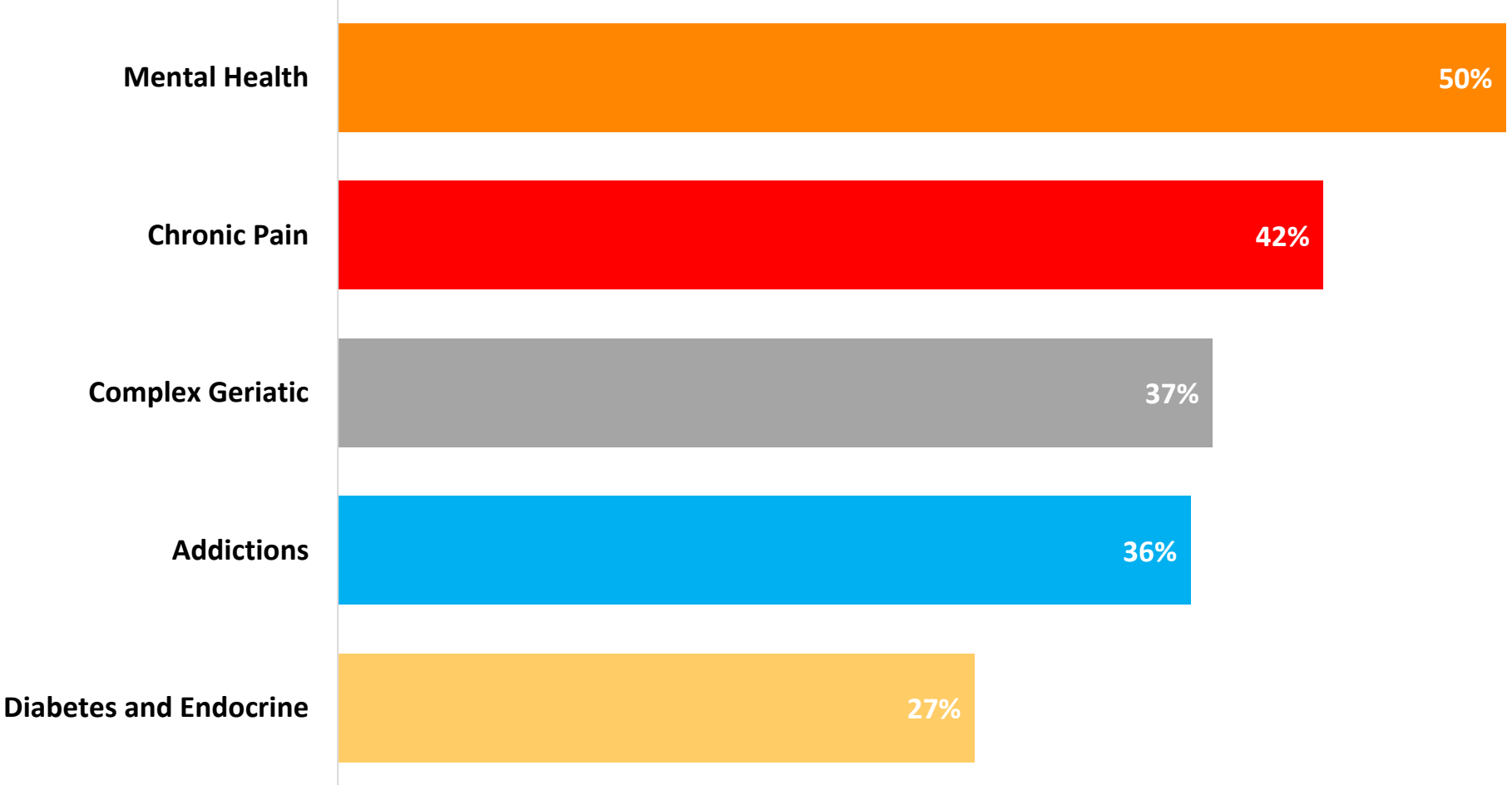


\$310 Member Fee Distribution

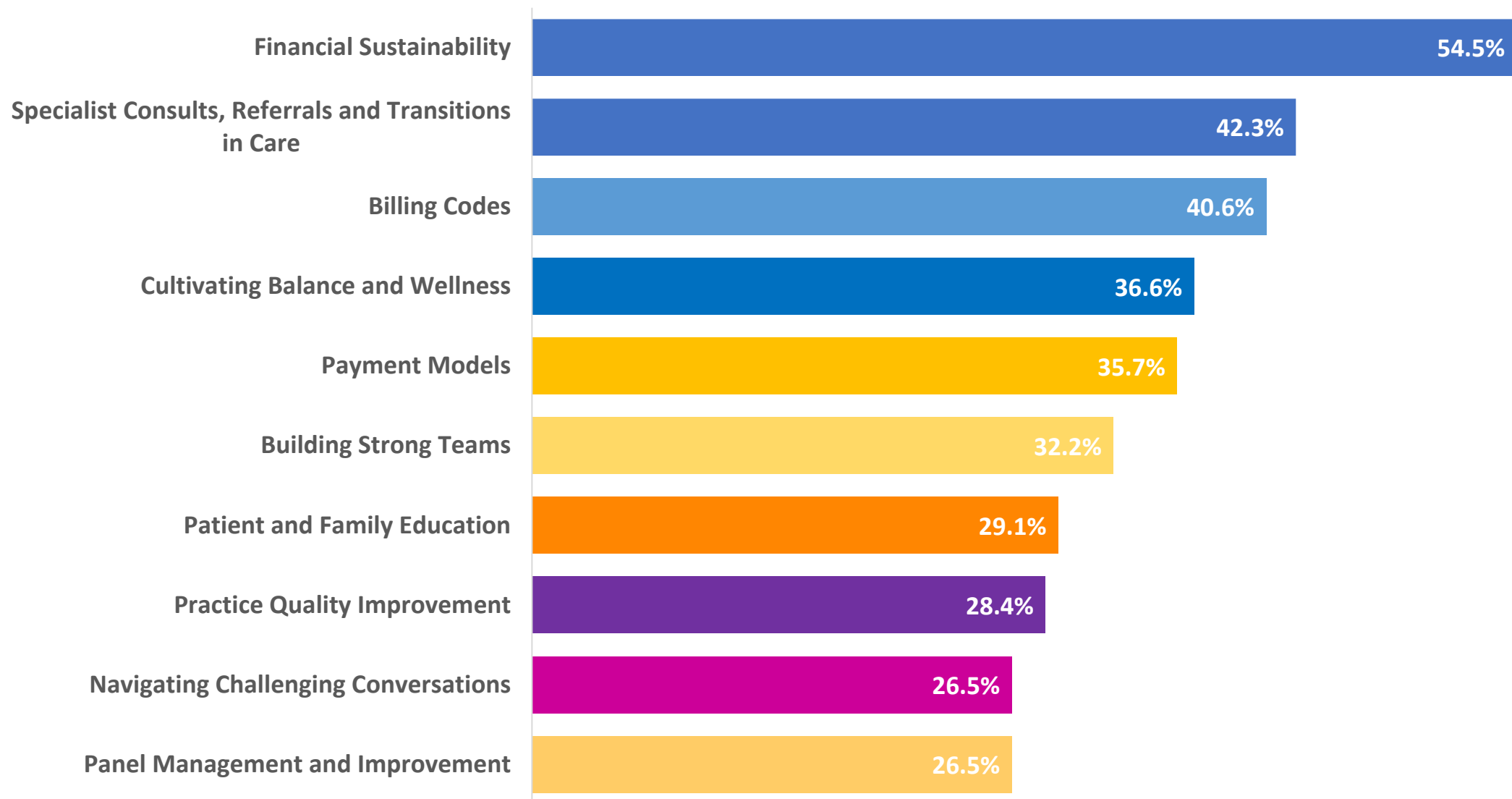


Top-Ranked Professional Development – Top 5 Clinical Areas

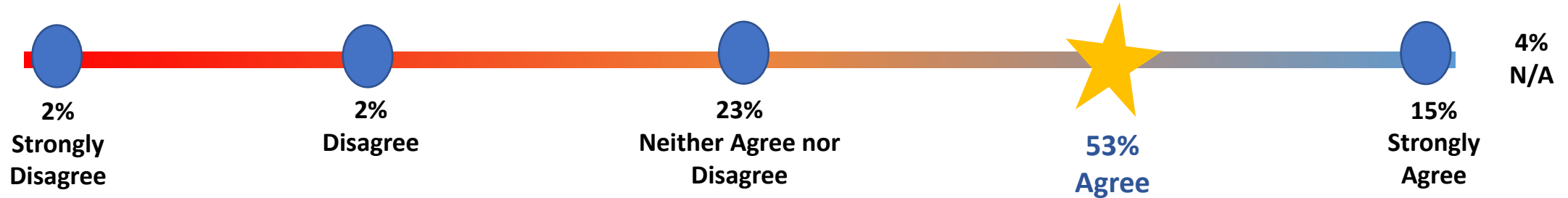


Top-Ranked Professional Development – Practice Management

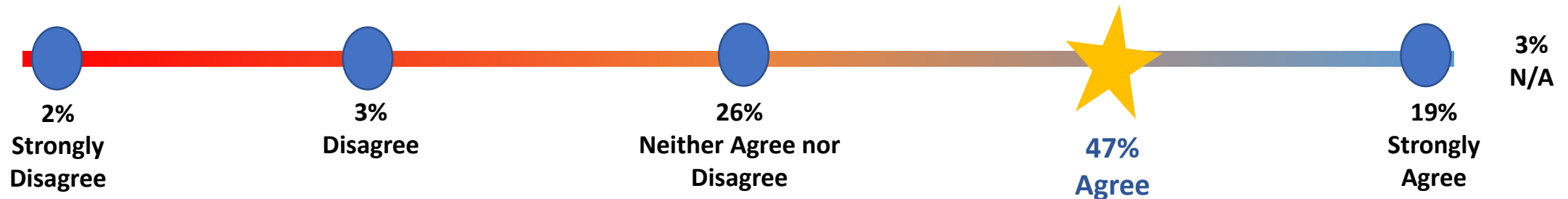

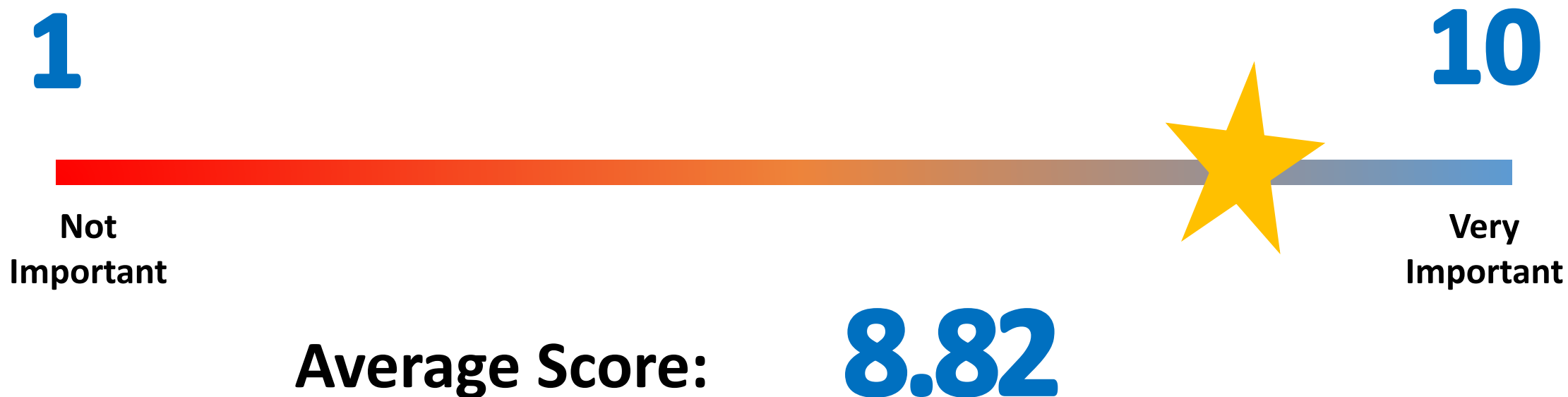

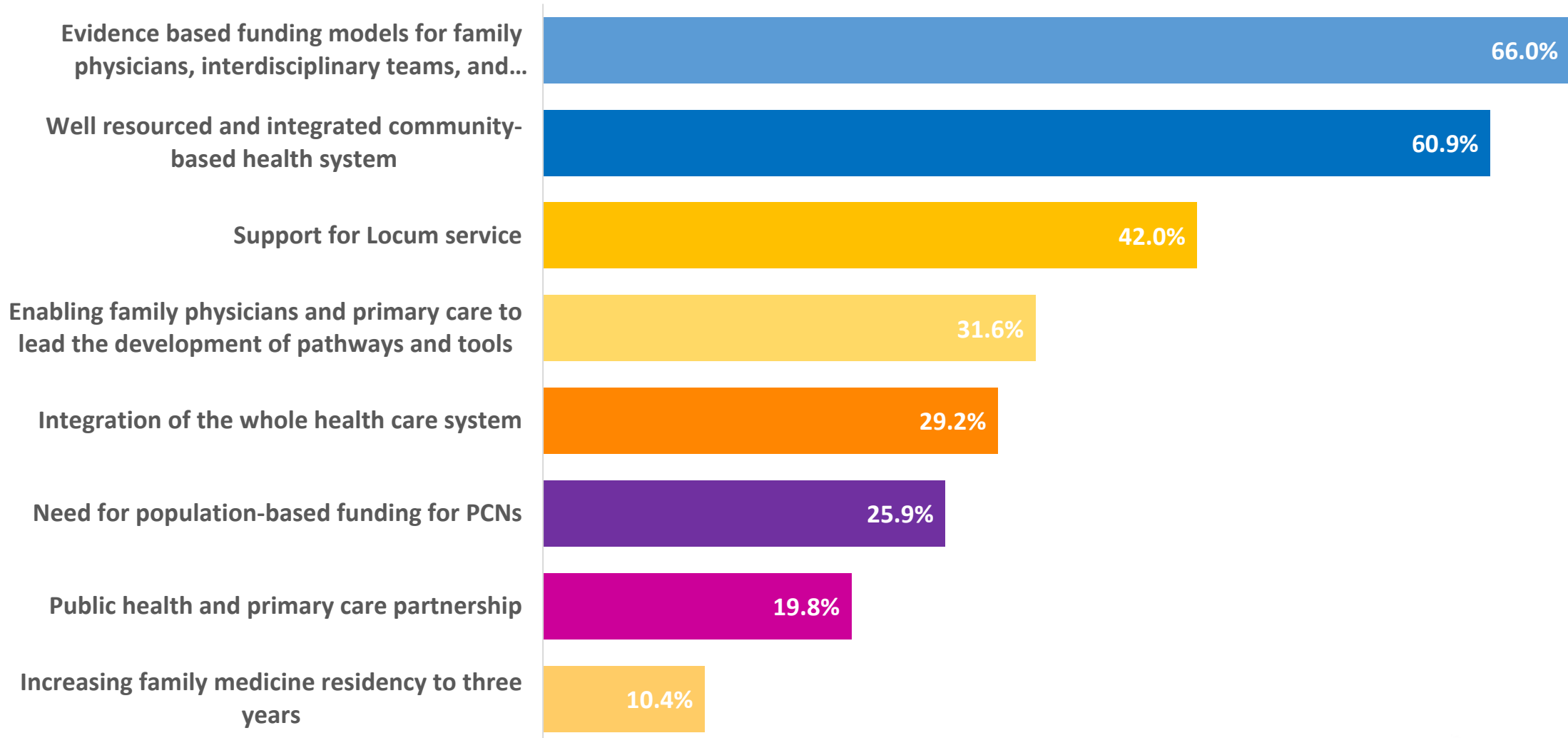

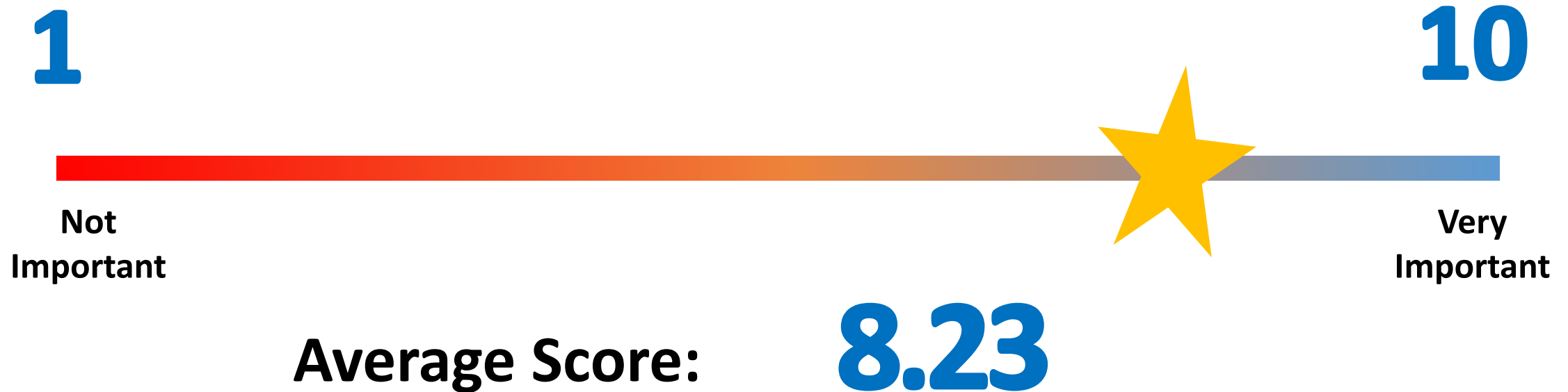
